## The Jog-a-thon's Coming! The Jog-a-thon's Coming!

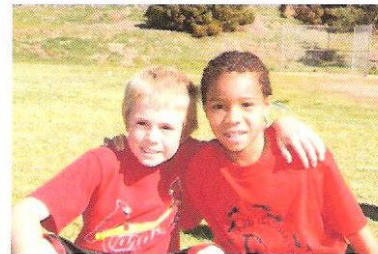

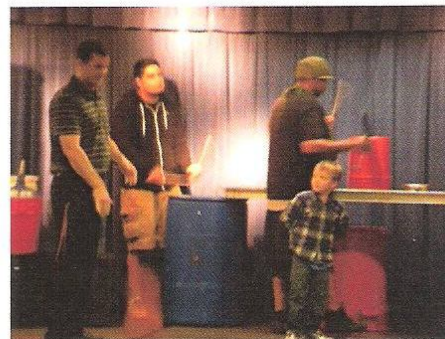
