Please review the following details to help ensure a smooth and successful school year.

* I will be on campus today (Sunday, 8/11) The doors will be closed and all areas locked, but if you'd like to show your child where their classroom is to prepare for tomorrow's arrival, I will unlock the front gate at 10:30 a.m. and lock it promptly at 11:00 a.m.

1st Day - Monday, August 12, Arrival (Minimum Day- Dismissal at 12:15pm)

The campus will be open to allow parents to walk students to their classrooms. No walking club

- The lower playground blacktop area will be open for parent parking
 - Please do not park in numbered spaces- these are staff parking spaces
 - o If Dropping off
 - Drop off on Cibola Rd. in the drop off area, or
 - Drop off in the staff parking lot, stay to the right and continue around to exit
 - Parking
 - Street parking available, best by Dailard Park
 - Do not park in the staff parking lot, in a numbered space
 - Please be careful and watch for students and other families
 - No u-turns on Cibola Rd
 - Do not block neighbor's driveways
 - Do not pull into the upper, school driveway
 - Walking Club area will be available for parking on the 1st day only



- Regular bell schedule
 - Gates open at 7:30am
 - o First bell at 7:45am
 - School begins at 7:50am
- MPR open to UTK/K/New families
 - Quick transitions after the bell are crucial so teachers can begin setting classroom norms. We understand that this can be challenging, especially for our youngest students who are new to school and sometimes even more so for their parents. To help ease this transition, we invite you to join us in the MPR for a brief meeting where you can grab a snack, connect with other parents and learn a bit about Mr. Wilson. The meeting will be short, allowing you to head to your next destination after drop off.

2nd Day - Return to a regular schedule for the remainder of the school year Bell Schedule

Parking

- Street parking available, best by Dailard Park
- Please be careful and watch for students and other families
- No u-turns on Cibola Rd
- Do not block neighbor's driveways
- Do not pull into the upper, school driveway
- There are a few visitor parking spaces at the exit of the staff lot, they are labeled Visitor
 - Do not park in a numbered space



Walking Club begins at 7:30am- Go directly to walking club or breakfast at arrival, please do not wait at classroom doors




Walking Club Rules

- Students are to find their class # painted on the blacktop and then put their backpacks behind it in a straight line.
- Students will then immediately walk the track- no running, yelling, or chasing for safety.
- No playing on hopscotch, painted map, play structure or wall ball. Walking the track only.
- You may walk with friends.
- Line up when the bell rings. Stand where your backpack is. **ALL** students should meet on the lower playground with backpacks behind their classroom number.
- All should be walking including parents and siblings that are still on campus.

 Those eating breakfast at school should still line up with their class. There should not be any students or family members waiting by the classroom doors or in the quad.

Dismissal

- Street parking is available if you plan on walking in to pick up your child
- If meeting your child somewhere, such as the park, please have a predetermined location
- If going in the drive through pick up on the lower blacktop (walking club area), please review the following reminders

- Don't Leave Your Car Unattended: Keep your vehicle attended at all times to ensure that it doesn't obstruct traffic or create safety hazards.
- Two Lanes Only: Use the designated two lanes for pick-up to ensure a smooth flow of traffic and safety for children.
- Remain in Your Car: While waiting for your child, stay in your vehicle to avoid congestion and potential accidents.
- Exit After Pick-Up: Once your child is safely in the car, exit the lot promptly to make room for other vehicles.
- Stop for Crossing Children: All cars must stop while children are crossing the lanes to ensure their safety.
- Popsicles on Fridays: Popsicles are available for purchase at the pick-up lot on Fridays for \$1.
- Lot Closes at 2:25: The pick-up lot closes at 2:25 PM. If you arrive after this time, your child will be taken to the office for pick-up.
